

## **Annual Report:**

### The DAR Project Annual Report 2016

The DAR Project became incorporated in New York State in 2012. We have also received our 501(c)(3) non-profit status from the IRS. Our mission is to offer educational resources to orphans in Tanzania. We focus primarily on funding tuition for students who are committed to serving their community.

The DAR Project brought in \$3,600.00 in cash donations in the 2016 calendar year. We hosted three major benefit events where we raised the majority of these donations, including our speech at a Medical Conference in Miami, Florida bringing in \$1,500. We held a benefit concert in Westchester, New York that brought in \$500. We also held a Clothing Drive that was held in New York City. We also brought in funds through individual donations that were received on our website, mailed checks and through cash donations totaling \$1,600. In addition to our major fundraising events of 2016, we sent five students to college in Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania. These students are studying business, economics, and nursing – our students who are attending university in Tanzania will be reporting back to their community and helping those in need, in addition to their efforts of helping build up the local economy and giving back in their local community.

Our 2016 Financial Summary is as follows: Program expenses (scholarships) = \$3,125.00  
Administration expenses = donated funds \$95\* Fundraising expenses = \$350\* Total raised = \$3,600

Ending net asset = \$475
